Overview	Printed full colour clear or opaque interlayer laminated between two sheets of clear toughened glass. Panels can be transparent, translucent, opaque or a combination of all three. Ideal for feature walls, partitions, balustrades, splashbacks, awnings and facades.
Installation	This product must be installed by an experienced glazier. bleux can arrange for installation and site measures in all capital cities if required.
Lead Time	Six to seven weeks from receipt of 50% deposit and purchase order. Please allow longer for customised colours and designs.
Product Specifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Maximum glass size 1580mm width x 4500mm length (depending on application and framework etc)</li><li>• For internal partitions, thickness can either be:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 4 + 4 (4mm + 1.52 (interlayer) + 4mm) – fully framed</li><li>• 6 + 6 (6mm + 1.52 (interlayer) + 6mm) – not fully framed</li></ul></li><li>• Also dependant on application of partitions (ie. framed, not framed, silicon butt-joined, etc)</li><li>• Can have non-toughened laminated glass depending on application</li><li>• Suitable for outdoor use, the laminated glass will not fade under UV exposure. Tests have been conducted on the glass that was equivalent to 12 years of full time sun exposure and the colour change in the glass was so minor, it could not be detected by the human eye.</li><li>• Final colours may vary to what is viewed “on screen”. bleux will only guarantee colours once a printed sample is approved</li><li>• Can be cleaned with standard cleaning products and a damp cloth</li></ul>
